

APPLICATION FOR THE NESIYA INSTITUTE'S 2012 KEHILLAH EXPERIENCE IN ISRAEL

Thank you for applying to Nesiya's 2012 Kehillah Experience in Israel. Applicants are accepted on a rolling basis. Prior to acceptance, a Nesiya staff member may contact you to schedule a telephone interview. Final admission to the program is contingent upon certification of good physical and mental health, based on submission of the required medical form. Required Application, Required References, and Optional Submissions

Applicants are required to submit an application and three references, including one parent reference and two references from teachers or advisors or other adults who know you well. The Nesiya Institute will be happy to receive any additional work or information about yourself, including examples of creative or academic work.

Submitting your Application:

Deposit

Applications must include a deposit of \$250. If this fee presents a hardship, please contact the Nesiya office. The deposit is refundable only: 1) in cases when the applicant is not accepted to the program or 2) in cases where the participant is unable to participate in the program due to lack of sufficient funding. Checks or money orders should be made payable to The Nesiya Institute. Nesiya does not accept credit cards.

Early Application Discounts, Deadlines, and Final Application Deadline:

Postmark or submit your application online by **December 12, 2011** to qualify for a **\$500 Early Application Discount**.

Postmark or submit your application online by **January 12, 2012** to qualify for a **\$400 Early Application Discount**.

Postmark or submit your application online by **February 13, 2012** to qualify for a **\$300 Early Application Discount**.

Postmark or submit your application online by **March 15, 2012** to qualify for a **\$150 Early Application Discount**.

The final application deadline is April 16, 2012.

Financial Support from Nesiya

Nesiya provides generous financial support based on demonstrated financial need and/or merit. Nesiya staff works closely with families to provide as much support as possible. **The first \$1,500 of all Nesiya financial awards (both need and merit-based) carries specific Nesiya fellowship requirements, including the fulfillment of a Nesiya Community Internship in an education or non-profit agency in the participant's home community during the year following participation in the summer program.** (Information on Nesiya fellowships can be found on Nesiya's website or requested from the Nesiya office). Any additional support awarded by Nesiya is a grant, for which no follow-up obligations are necessary.

Need-Based Support

Need-based scholarship decisions are based on the submission of a financial aid form, the program application, and a Community Internship Proposal. All need-based applicants are also required to seek support from local sources. Please contact Nesiya if you need help identifying sources of funding in your community. To apply for need-based financial assistance, please complete and submit the Nesiya financial aid form and the Community Internship Proposal. These forms can be downloaded from www.nesiya.org or requested from the Nesiya office.

Merit-Based Support

Nesiya offers a limited number of \$1,000 merit-based Nesiya Community Internship awards. For additional information about the Nesiya Community Internship awards, please visit Nesiya's website.

In addition, Nesiya currently offers merit-based awards of varying amounts, to:

- Alumni of select peer programs (e.g. Genesis, Bima, Panim, Etgar 36)
- Current or past applicants to the Bronfman Youth Fellowships in Israel
- Special fellowships to young people who live in specific regions of the US and Israel, currently including Cleveland, OH; Massachusetts State; Washington State; and the Bay Area, CA.
